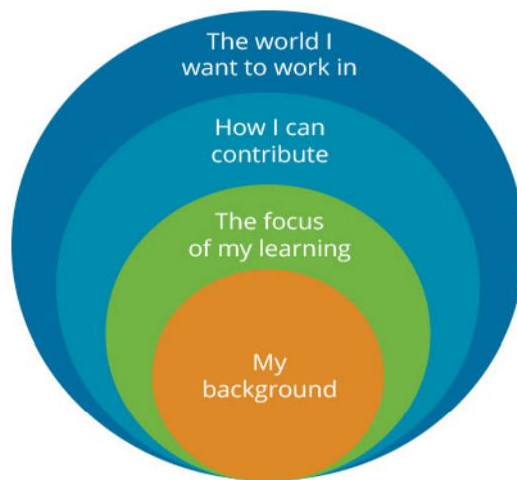


Information for those taking the CareerSmart career assessment.



Imagine that your world can be a good place to live and work in. What would that look, feel and be like? This is a useful start to exploring ideas for your future work; and knowing how your background can influence your contribution will help you to learn and to flourish into the future.

We know that making study, career and work decisions is hard, at the best of times, however this assessment should help the process of making these choices easier for you.

The process when taking this assessment will look like this:



What to expect when you take the assessment:

- Allow between 40 and 60 minutes to complete the full assessment. Take your time to think through the questions. This will give you a more useful result.
- If you need to, you can **take a break** from the assessment and go back to complete it when you have more time.
- You can check the section before the one you are on if you feel you need to refine your answers, however, once you get to the end, it is not possible to go back through the entire assessment. You can further refine your responses when you work with your career educator to review your results.
- As soon as you have finished the assessment, **your report will be emailed to your career educator.**
- Finally, your career educator is a fully licensed to use the CareerSmart assessment and will assist you to make good career decisions.
